

Discover: RCIA

RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults. RCIA is a faith formation process that enables adults who have not received some or all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, or Confirmation) to enter fully into the Roman Catholic Church.

St. Francis of Assisi offers all of the stages of RCIA from September through April each year. During that time period, there are weekly meetings on Wednesday nights from 7:30pm – 9:00pm in the Br. Juniper room, and the meetings are facilitated by the RCIA team, led by Fr. Kevin.

The initial period of inquiry offers the opportunity to learn some of the basics of Roman Catholicism before committing to the full formation process. The period of the catechumenate is the longest stage and is when those in formation learn about Roman Catholic beliefs and faith life. The final stage before the Easter Vigil is the period of purification and preparation, and it is an intense time of prayer and ritual leading to initiation, which is the culmination of the RCIA process.

The RCIA team is always looking for sponsors from the parish to accompany those seeking initiation by participating in each of the rites and discussing the journey throughout the process. If the answer to your Now What? question is to work one-on-one with someone seeking initiation, volunteer to be a sponsor.
