

From the Pastor's Desk

Two things I want to inform you about. First, I have some sad news to share with you. I just learned that Deacon Chuck Allen died. Deacon Chuck served here at St. Francis for a number of years as a deacon. He just retired this past May, sold his home and moved with his wife Judy to Arizona. I went on line and found

the following obituary: Charles "Chuck" Christian Allen, 72, of Goodyear, Arizona, passed away surrounded by his family on Saturday, October 24, 2015. Chuck was born May 31, 1943 in Hobbs, New Mexico. He graduated from the Air Force Academy class of 1965, retiring after 21 years of honorable service. He received his masters from Stanford in 1966 and he also received his BA in Theology from The College of Santa Fe in May of 1976. He was an active Catholic deacon of 38 years. On January 25, 1969 he married Judith "Judy" Liebeck. Chuck was employed as a Nuclear and Laser Physicist for Engility (formerly TASC) and he supported DTRA (Defense Threat Reduction Agency). He was an avid handball player and was state champion of New Mexico in 1976. Chuck is survived by his wife Judy, three sons, Philip Michael, Charles Randolph, Robert Christian, and daughter Laurie; seven grandchildren and one great grandchild. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather. He loved to mentor his grandchildren in the areas of math and science and religion. May he rest in peace!!

The second thing I want to share with you is some "numbers" that Francia, our Director of St. Francis House shared with me on your generosity to the poor this past Christmas:

The Knights of Columbus donated 56 Christmas Baskets for St. Francis House clients.

The Cub Scout Pack 1385 adopted 3 families from St. Francis House clients and provided presents for the whole family. The Boy Scout Troop 138 also provided a Christmas dinner for one family whose mother is ill with cancer.

Christmas presents were given to 300 families. Over 720 children received 2 presents each from the 1440 presents donated by parishioners that were worth more than \$50,000.

70 gift bags were put together by the Seniors and donated to the residents of Envoy Nursing Home in Woodbridge, VA

Monetary donations were received and were given to: Project Rachel & Gabriel \$540, Birthright \$560, Mary's Shelter \$545. The Migration and Refugee Ministry of the Diocese received \$800 in gift cards and personal items, such as, microwaves, dinnerware, strollers, pot sets, etc. that was worth more than \$1,000.

Volunteer hours: MANY! Francia couldn't have done it without the help of so many wonderful volunteers.
