Below is the announcement that the Bishop and our Minister Provincial asked me to read at the Masses last weekend. As noted in the announcement I have been asked to serve as the Parochial Administrator of the Parish until this matter is resolved. Fr. Frank Critch, O.F.M., has returned temporarily to the Parish to assist me and Br. Henry Fulmer, O.F.M., who has joined our Parish staff on a permanent basis.

This is obviously a very difficult moment for our Parish and especially for Fr. Kevin. Please keep him in your prayers. If you would like to contact him, I would ask that you please bring your cards and letters to the Parish Office and we will forward them to him, as Fr. Kevin has moved from this area.

While serving as your Parochial Administrator, I am her to be of assistance to you in any way possible. I very much appreciate your support and prayers.

"I need to share with you some unfortunate news. Fr. Kevin Downey, O.F.M., our Pastor here at St. Francis of Assisi, was placed on administrative leave this past Friday pending the investigation of an allegation against him of abuse of a minor. This allegation dates back to 1990, and did not involve anyone at our Parish or in this diocese.

Fr. Kevin has denied the accusation, but it is a matter that must be investigated. The investigation is in the early stages and no final determination has been made.

The diocese and the Franciscans of Holy Name Province are committed to full cooperation regarding this allegation. The diocese's formal announcement is available on the diocesan web page as is its child protection policy. This will also be announced in the Catholic Herald.

During this investigation, I have been asked to serve as the Parochial Administrator of St. Francis, to assist in the administrative and spiritual care of our Parish family. If I can be of any assistance to you, please feel free to contact me. We have asked Fr. Frank Critch, O.F.M., who most of you know, to return for a few weeks to help me.

The Bishop has informed me that we, the St. Francis Parish Community are in his prayers as well as the prayers of the entire diocesan community. Be assured also of the prayers of the friars of Holy Name Province.

Please keep Fr. Kevin and all those involved in this unfortunate situation in your prayers."
