We have been for the last couple of years, participants in the Prince William County Church Safety

Program. As part of this program, representatives of the County Police meet with us to periodically review our security procedures and make recommendation where necessary.

As I mentioned in last weeks bulletin, we have recently installed several surveillance cameras on our property. These cameras monitor our surroundings on a 24/7 basis.

Finally, this past Thursday I attended a special program on security issues presented by the Prince William County Police Department.

St. Francis of Assisi parish has supported the Un-Trim-A-Tree Program for more than 16 years, providing assistance for families in need in Dumfries, Triangle, and Quantico. This year St. Francis of Assisi will also be providing gifts for a number of refugee families sponsored by Catholic Charities and the Bill Mehr Homeless Shelter. To assist you in the process we have some answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the request date.

Do Not Wrap the present

What is the tag for? The tag is very important as it indicates the individual information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. When you get the tag home, copy the information down or take a picture to ensure that if you lose the tag you still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? On November 19th, St. Francis of Assisi will place a Christmas Angel Giving Tree on display in the vestibule of the church; gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily. Presents must be returned by Sunday, December 10th. (NO Exceptions)

Can I give additional items than those requests on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.



Fallen Heroes interred at Quantico **National Cemetery**

The Quantico Wreath Project, conducted annually by the SGT MAC

FOUNDATION, will be supported again in 2017 by the Knights of Columbus with assistance from the Columbiettes.



Fundraising at St. Francis of Assisi Parish will take place during the weekends of November 18th-19th and 25th-26th. On Saturday, December 2nd, volunteers will place wreaths on the graves at Quantico National Cemetery. All of the wreaths used to decorate the graves of our fallen heroes are purchased with donated funds (\$10 for each wreath). Each year we have been able to raise more money and decorate more graves. Last vear we decorated 10,000 graves in Sections 9 & 10 of Quantico National Cemetery and this year we hope to be able to decorate the 13,000. Representatives from the Knights and the Columbiettes will accept donations at a table on the center circle after each Mass on the fundraising weekends. Checks will be accepted and should be made payable to the SGT MAC FOUNDATION.
