CARE FOR CREATION and CELEBRATE Earth Day, on Sunday April 22nd by planting a tree seedling. <u>The Care for</u> <u>Creation Committee will be</u> <u>giving away 1,000 Black</u> <u>Locust tree seedlings after</u> <u>Sunday Masses on April 22nd</u>. It is best to plant the seedling immediately, so that the roots



do not dry out. Please clear a 3'x3' area of all vegetation before planting. Water your baby tree once a week. Your tree will grow up to be 50 feet tall and a foot in diameter. Flowers on this tree are an important nectar source for honey bees, and the honey bees need our help!
