## Freedom Bears for Court

Being a witness is not a common experience for most adults, let alone for children. Court can be a daunting place, especially when you are worried about what is going to happen. Now imagine being a child and going to court because you have been a victim of sexual abuse. Children are anxious and afraid to see their abuser and testify in front of everyone in the courtroom. Fortunately, a child does not have to go through this process alone. At ACTS Sexual Assault Services, we provide counseling, support and court accompaniment. One special counseling tool we use are Freedom Bears. These unique bears come with a small piece of paper on which victims can write down the name of the person who harmed them and stick it in the bear's heart. When the child is ready, whether it be hours or years later, they can take the paper out, drop it in water and watch it dissolve, which can be a cathartic experience. Children also bring their Freedom Bear to court to not only help them tell their story but to also provide comfort before and after testifying.
