**From
the
Friars**

A week ago the Arlington Catholic Diocese published a list of priests with credible accusations of sexual abuse. The diocese of Richmond published a similar list. These priests have been removed from ministry and in some cases are deceased.

In the weeks and months ahead, you will see numerous diocese and religious orders release such lists. The demand for full disclosure and action on cases of sexual abuse has expanded beyond the Catholic Church. Just this week the Southern Baptist Church announced allegations against some 300 clergy and leaders of their church.

The State of New York has recently passed legislation that will allow expanded investigation into these cases including, for the first time, the Public School system.

On a more positive note, I am happy to announce that our annual appeal brought in \$195,981 this year compared to \$152,000 last year.

That figure does not include the \$100,000 gift from a couple who wishes to remain anonymous. With the inclusion of that gift the appeal brought in just under \$300,000.

My deepest appreciation to all who contributed to the appeal this year.

Two members of our parish, Gene Sellers and Mary Lou Koehl were featured speakers at the recent Diocese of Arlington conference on Anti-Human Trafficking.

The work of Gene and Mary Lou, and St Francis of Assisi parish, was presented as "a model for Christian communities working to help victims of Anti-Human Trafficking".

Congratulations to Gene and Mary Lou and our parish committee members!

The evil of Human Trafficking was, for years, thought to be a problem affecting only countries overseas. It has now become a major problem here in the U.S.

Fasting and abstinence are encouraged during Lent and reflect the season's penitential nature. In the U.S. all Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence, that is, days on which no meat is to be consumed. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are days of fast, only one full meal during the day, as well as abstinence.

Fasting and abstinence are by no means the only types of penance. "Let us witness to our love and imitation of Christ by special solicitude for the sick, the poor, the underprivileged, the imprisoned, the bedridden, the discouraged, the lowly." (Tobit 12, Mt 6).

Soup and Stations—Fridays (starting March 8th) during Lent we will celebrate Soup and Stations at **6:00 p.m.** with a soup and bread dinner in the **Parish Center Dining Facility**, followed by the **Stations of the Cross in the Church at 7:00 p.m.** Each week a different group will sponsor the dinner and St. Francis Lectors will lead the Stations that evening. Please join us in this time of fellowship and prayer.

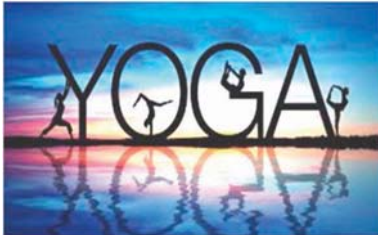


Kairos Prison Ministry Asks for Your Support

HIS WORD TODAY
 By Rev. William J. Reilly



“But love your enemies and do good to them, and lend expecting nothing back; then your reward will be great and you will be children of the Most High, for he himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked. Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful... Stop judging... stop condemning, forgive and you will be forgiven.”

If we wished to choose one word to describe the ministry of Pope Francis, it would be ‘mercy.’ His writings reflect this teaching of Jesus in the beatitudes. He proclaimed a holy year of mercy. He constantly is extending the compassionate hand of Jesus to the poor and marginalized.

Luke’s teaching asks us to consider what seems so difficult. Love enemies, give without expecting a return, be concerned for ungrateful and those so distant from the gospel.

When driving and someone cuts you off, pray for him. If you are offended by someone’s remark, chalk it up to a bad day and do not brood over it. Do not live the expression ‘I don’t get mad, I get even.’ Spend a moment discerning who might be an ‘enemy’ and seek a way to open the door to friendship, by prayer, a smile, or another sign of peace.

Did not Jesus tell us to forgive so we may be forgiven.

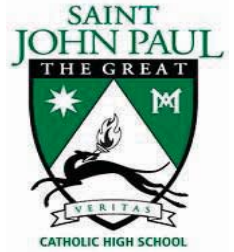
