As part of our Summer repair projects we have painted the Church walls. You may notice that they are now a darker color. I believe the darker color better complements our Beautiful Stations of the Cross and gives the ambience of the Church a more sacred feel.

Other projects that will take place this Summer include repair, sealing, and new striping of the parking lot, power washing the Parish Center—School building, replacing several concrete slabs (between the Church and Parish Center) that have sunken and cause puddles to form.

The Parish Center and Gym will also receive its yearly painting (where necessary) and floor refinishing.

On a very different topic, our new Psychological Counselor, Peter Drabbant has settled in and has already seen a number of clients. He is available to all parishioners as needed, on Tuesdays from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Fees are based on a sliding scale. The telephone number for appointments is posted on the bulletin board on the right as you exit Church, and also at the parish office and on the parish website.

Finally, the Free Medical Clinic in Woodbridge may have to close. Catholic Charities has been offered the Clinic and may take ownership for it. If they do, they will need part-time volunteers such as: Nurses, doctors, staff positions to help there.

I will have more information on this project in the next few weeks.

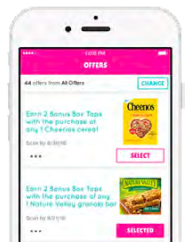

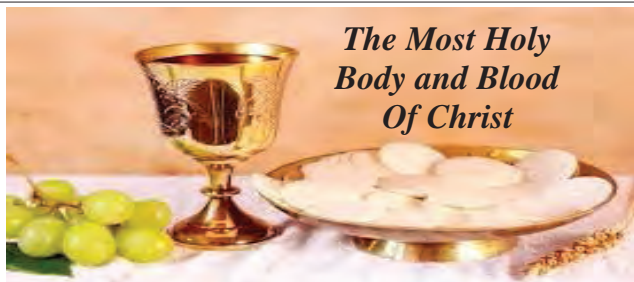
