From
the
Friars

This past week we celebrated the feast of St. Francis of Assisi.

We are currently as a global community confronting what potentially may be the greatest crisis humanity may face, Global Warming.

When this issue first came up I, like I suspect many others, was skeptical as to whether there really was a problem. I am no longer skeptical. I have read the evidence and have conversed with individuals whose lives and livelihood are already being impacted by this crisis. Evidence is now showing that we are being negatively impacted by Global Warming even more quickly than experts first thought.

When we think of St. Francis we often think of Francis and the "birdbath." It is a pleasant but also convenient way to relegate his message on creation to irrelevancy.

In the words of one Franciscan scholar, Fr. Dan Horan, "People love St. Francis but they often view him as naive, romantic, cutesy, an unthreatening figure. The early Franciscan sources reveal he was anything but these things".

The message of Francis was relevant 800 years ago and is even more relevant today. All of creation is sacred because God created it. We have a most serious responsibility to care for it.

In the words of Pope Francis in his encyclical *Laudato Si* "We must see that everything is interconnected and all of creation is a universal family. Nature cannot be seen as something apart from humanity or merely a place where we live."

We have an urgent mission to do something now to save our planet. If not for ourselves, for the sake of our children!

It is the Franciscan mission we are all challenged to be a part of.

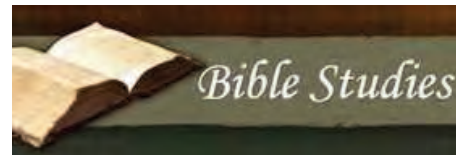

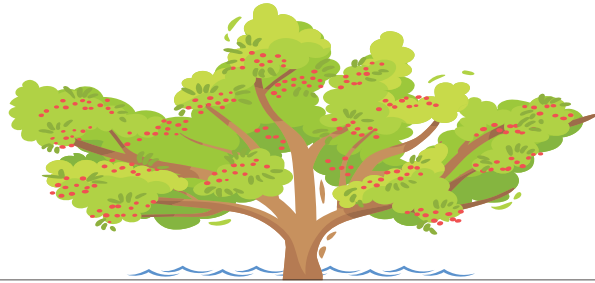
