Pray with her, offering Christ's love at a crucial lifesaving and life-defining moment.

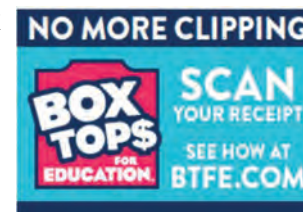

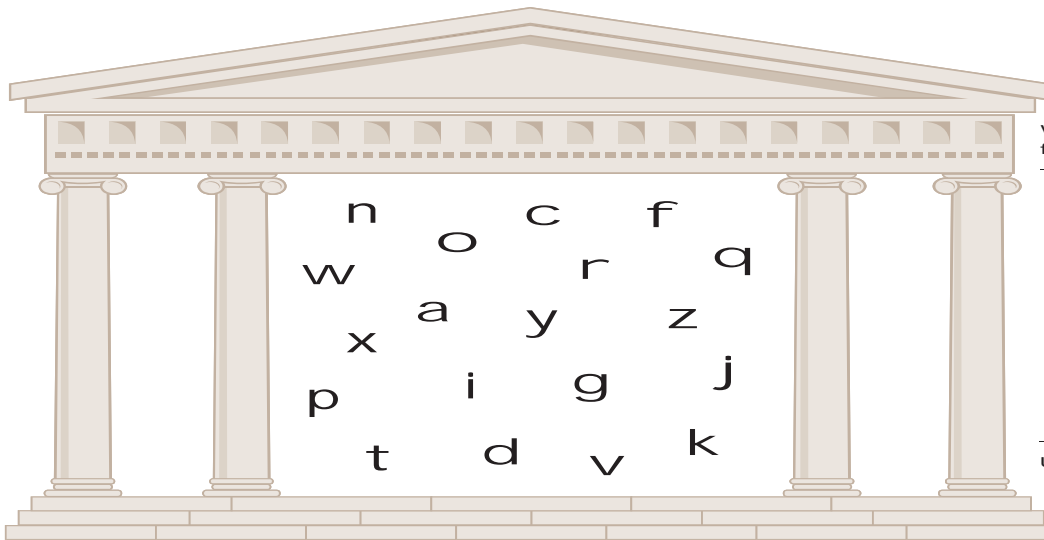
