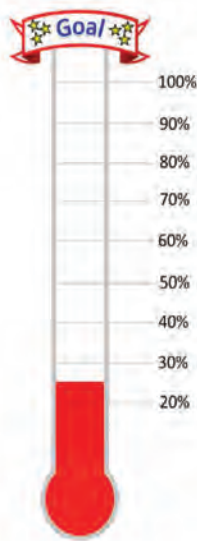
**2019 St. Francis Parish Appeal**

**What is the tag for?** **The tag is very important** as it indicates the individual's information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. **When you pull a tag from one of the trees, copy the information down or take a picture of the tag** to ensure that if you lose the tag you will still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

**Where do I drop the Present?** Gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily.

**Presents must be returned by Sunday, December 8th.**  
**(NO Exceptions)**

**Can I give additional items than those requests on the tag?** Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.

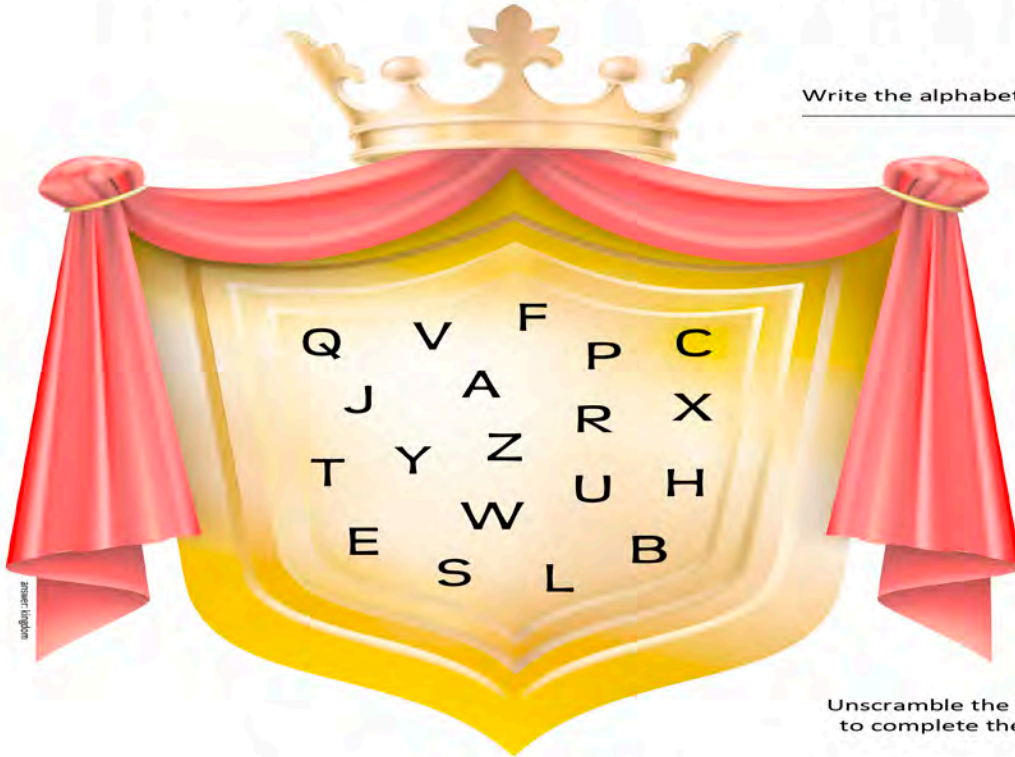
