UN-TRIM-A-TREE



St. Francis of Assisi parish has supported the **Un-Trim-A-Tree Program** for more than 17 years, providing assistance for families in need in Dumfries, Triangle, and Quantico. This year St. Francis of Assisi will also be providing gifts for a number of refugee families sponsored by Catholic Charities and the Bill Mehr Homeless Shelter. To assist you in the process we have answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the request date. **Do Not Wrap the present**

What is the tag for? **The tag is very important** as it indicates the individual's information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. **When you pull a tag from one of the trees, copy the information down or take a picture of the tag** to ensure that if you lose the tag you will still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? Gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily.

Presents must be returned by Sunday, December 8th.
(NO Exceptions)

Can I give additional items other than those requests on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.

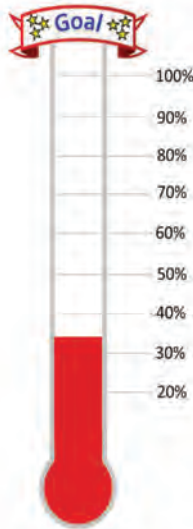
2019 St. Francis Parish Appeal

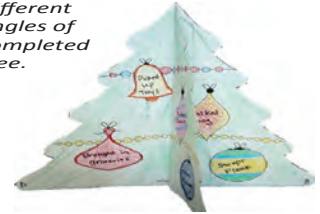

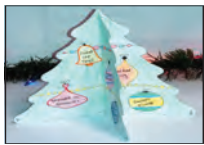
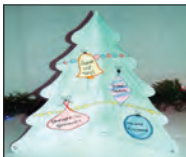
- [1] Color the tree green, write your good deeds on the ornaments and color them in.

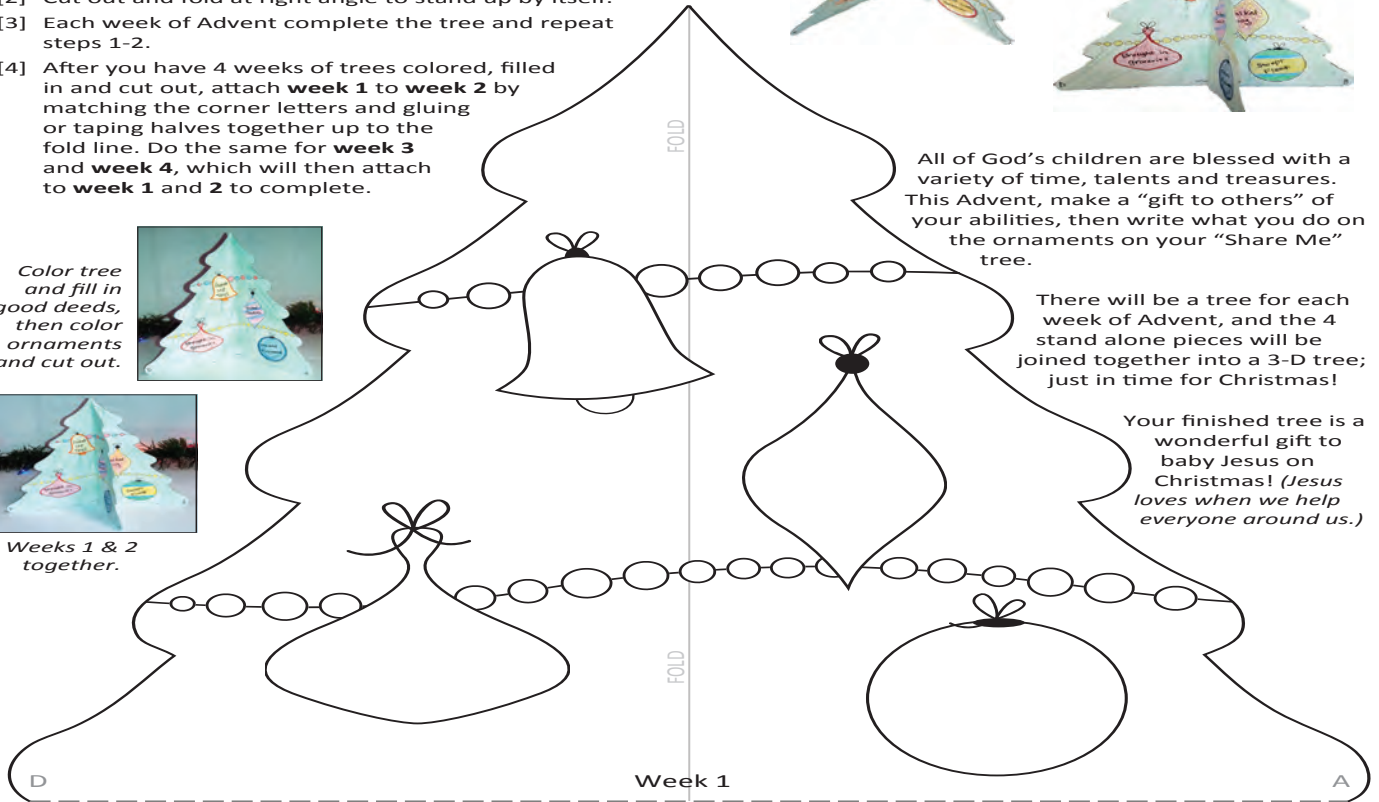
Different angles of completed tree.
