**St. Francis of Assisi parish has supported the Un-Trim-A-Tree Program for more than 17 years**, providing assistance for families in need in Dumfries, Triangle, and Quantico. This year St. Francis of Assisi will also be providing gifts for a number of refugee families sponsored by Catholic Charities and the Bill Mehr Homeless Shelter. To assist you in the process we have answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the request date. <u>Do Not Wrap the present</u>

What is the tag for? The tag is very important as it indicates the individual's information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. When you pull a tag from one of the trees, copy the information down or take a picture of the tag to ensure that if you lose the tag you will still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? Gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily.

### <u>Presents must be returned by Sunday, December 8th</u>. (<u>NO</u> Exceptions)

Can I give additional items other than those requests on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.



Next Saturday, December 7th Please Come Help Distribute the Christmas Wreaths at Quantico National Cemetery




