





DIRECTIONS TO MAKE A STAR FOR THE TOP OF YOUR ADVENT "SHARE ME" TREE

1] Color twin stars yellow

Planet Home Lending

- 2] Color diamond (the space between the stars) green to match your tree
- 3] Cut out the double star on dotted line
- 4] Fold on gray solid line and glue together to form double-sided star
- 51 Cut through both stars from dot-to-dot and slip over top of tree between weeks 1 & 3 or 2 & 4



If you don't have a paper tree, hang your finished star in a window as an Epiphany reminder.
