From the Friars As was announced recently at the weekend Masses, the administration of Holy Name Province (Franciscan Friars) recently completed a year long process of evaluating the ministries currently staffed by the friars. As a result of that process, the administration has decided to withdraw

from 10 currently staffed ministries of the Province, including 8 parishes.

I am pleased to announce that The Province will continue to staff our parish, St. Francis of Assisi, Triangle.

This process was undertaken for two reasons, the declining number of friars available for ministry, and as a preparation for the eventual merge of the 6 U.S. Franciscan O.F.M. Provinces into one U.S. Province. This merge is expected to take place in 2023.






Gospel Today
