FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT



I am deeply aware that the decision to cancel Masses indefinitely, is very disappointing to all of you. It is especially difficult in this season of Lent. The decision by Bishop Burbidge was not made without extensive consultation with local, State, and

Federal Health authorities.

As Catholics, Christians we have a responsibility to protect those most vulnerable in our communities and society. We must do whatever necessary to risk the spread of this virus.

We are currently working with a very limited staff but the office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday thru Thursday, and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Friday. If you need to visit the office. I ask that you first stop in the lobby of the office area until the receptionist motions for you to enter. Once you enter, I ask that you keep a 6-foot distance between yourself and the receptionist. If at some point the Governor orders a "Shelter in Place" we will of course have to close the Church offices.

Though Mass is suspended during the next few weeks, the Church will be open on Saturday and Sunday as well as weekdays. I encourage you to stop by, say a prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, at which time you can drop off your donation (in the Catch-All slot); or any food you would like to donate to Francis House. The hours will be Monday thru Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Friday 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Sunday 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

I encourage you to do the best you can to continue the Lenten journey and to pray with your families daily The Lord is never far from us in troubled times, and He is certainly with us now. Together with his support we will get through this most difficult moment.

To help us stay in touch with each other I will be communicating with you on a regular basis through the Parish website and E-Newsletter. We are also looking into setting up a live stream of Sunday Mass from our beautiful Church.

May God bless you and your loved ones.



HIS WORD TODAY
By Rev. William J. Reilly



"I will put my spirit in you that you may live, and I will settle you in your own land, thus you shall know that I am the Lord. I have promised, and I will do it, says the Lord... If the Spirit of the one who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, the One who raised Christ from the dead, will give life to your mortal bodies also, through the spirit dwelling in you."

Jesus told us He came that we might have life, and have it in its fullness. The pending celebration of Holy Week and the Paschal Mystery are the steps He took to restore us to that life. As He brought Lazarus from death, He wishes us to be renewed. His promises never fail and He wishes to give life to our mortal bodies. What is this life? It is the life of grace, the very life of God, given as a gift, and accepted.

Is the spirit of God dwelling in you? Do you want Him to restore you to life in abundance? Perhaps the sacrament of reconciliation, confession, are the steps we can take to be sure that His gift is in us.

We never learned how Lazarus felt when Jesus touched him. How will you feel?

depression, anxiety, obsessive compulsive disorder and scrupulosity; trauma; anger; behavioral issues; substance use; and couple/marital issues. He has provided group therapy for those with personality disorders (DBT), substance use



disorders (IOP) and Anger Management groups.






#### 2020 Bishop's Lenten Appeal Steadfast in Faith and Joyful in Hope


