

"Brothers and sisters: No one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God which produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit... For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body... and we were all given to drink of the one Spirit."
