Sentara Healthcare Limited Free Testing for Eligible Prince William County Residents, Wednesday, July 8, 2020



To assist public health officials, contain the spread of **COVID-19** in <u>overlooked/undertested communities of color</u>, Sentara Healthcare is offering free testing for those communities in Prince Willian County. Testing is for persons experiencing COVID-19 symptoms and need to be tested for the virus. Symptoms or combinations of symptoms include:

Cough – Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing – Fever – Chills Shaking with chills – Muscle pain – Headache – Sore throat – loss of taste or smell or Diarrhea. In the elderly, there may also be a change in behavior and/or appetite.

If you, or a member of your household <u>exhibits one or more of the symptoms</u>, Sentara wants to offer you **free testing on Wednesday, July 8**. <u>Priority</u> is given to those working high-risk jobs for transmission, an elderly resident, and a resident of Prince William County, Manassas or Manassas Park, or homeless persons exhibiting symptoms.

If a member of your household needs to receive this free COVID-19 testing, please come to one of the sites listed:

Testing is completely free and confidential. Sentara Healthcare staff perform all nasal swab testing. They will call all residents with their results, both negative and positive, or work with the local health department staff to contact patients without phones.

Testing will occur on Wednesday, July 8th. Tents and tables will be setup. Adherence to Social Distancing will also be followed.
