Some good PWC VOICE news to share: Schools Organizing—recently, we learned from the School Board that VOICE played a major role in securing \$3.4 million in new "Economically Disadvantaged" funding to support low-income students and schools. At our last fundraiser in October 2019 we had a goal of \$4.5m, so this is a good outcome given the huge damage done to the school systems' budget by COVID. (We are told that had COVID not come along we would likely have won around \$9m!).

Originally, the plan was for the money to be used to support after-school programs and ESOL for parents, but COVID has obviously upended things. However, the funding will allow schools, especially those with large concentrations of low-income families, the flexibility to provide additional services--hiring an extra social worker. for example--that are critically needed to support vulnerable families during the pandemic.

Public Defender Office—the PWC Public Defender office is fully operational and accepting cases. Over the summer they brought on their first Chief Defender (Ms. Tracey Lenox), secured office space, and started hiring staff. The office will increase their caseload as they continue to hire and train attorneys and staff with a goal of being at full capacity by the first of the year.

Additionally, assisted suicide fosters discrimination by creating two classes of people: those whose suicides we spend millions of dollars to prevent and those whose suicides we assist and treat as a positive good.

#### **HIS WORD TODAY**

By Rev. William J. Reilly



"I have called you by your name, given you a title, though you knew me not. I am the Lord and there is no other, there is no God besides me... We give thanks to God for all of you, remembering you in our prayers, unceasingly calling to mind your work of faith and labor of love, and endurance in hope of our Lord Jesus Christ... Knowing, brothers and sisters loved by God, how you were chosen."

Piecing together these words of Isaiah and Paul, may we reflect upon them. Perhaps we can create an image, as we picture someone—a family member or friend, a religious sister, brother or priest, a fellow parishioner—to whom we wish to direct these words, for they seem to describe them well.

We move now to ourselves, and wonder how well do they apply to me? I know I have been chosen and called. My baptism tells me this. The follow up is so important as we live our faith and produce our labor of love.

Think of Paul's word that you are 'loved by God' and the response He wishes and expects from us.




