To assist you in the process we have some answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the requested date. <u>Do Not Wrap the present</u>

What is the tag for? <u>The tag is very important</u> as it indicates the individual's information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. <u>When you pull a tag from one of the trees, copy the</u> <u>information down or take a picture of the tag</u> to ensure that if you lose the tag you will still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? Gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily.

Presents must be returned by Monday, December 14th.

(<u>NO</u> Exceptions)

Can I give additional items than those requests on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.
