Peter, a native of Canada, is licensed as both a professional counselor (LPC) and a drug/alcohol counselor (CAADC / IC-RC). He is new to the region and to Catholic Charities for the Diocese of Arlington. Residing and providing therapy services in Michigan for 15 years, he ran a Catholic private practice for a few years and in 2006, joined a CMH (Community Mental Health) agency for 12 years providing individual therapy and crisis intervention for both adults and youth; treating those affected with depression, anxiety, obsessive compulsive disorder and scrupulosity; trauma; anger; behavioral issues; substance use; and couple/marital issues. He has provided group therapy for those with personality disorders (DBT), substance use disorders (IOP) and Anger Management groups.

A fresh perspective on the Sunday Readings

HIS WORD TODAY

By Rev. William J. Reilly



"Go up onto a high mountain, Zion, herald of glad tidings; cry out at the top of your voice, Jerusalem, herald of good news! Fear not to cry out and say to the cities of Judah: Here is your God! He comes with power, the Lord God, who rules by his strong arm... Like a shepherd he feeds his flock, in his arms he gathers the lambs, carrying them in his bosom, and leading the ewes with care."

Writing centuries before Christ, the prophet calls us today to once again make the same great announcement. The 'hear ye, hear ye' of the Isaiah era, echoes in our hearts as we speak not only of the need of Jesus' saving grace, but its coming to us once more. We too are called to reveal His coming in grace, His power.

Today we call this the work of heralding 'evangelization', and our advent task is to prepare His way and make sure He is known. The same Jesus feeds, gathers and carries us, leading with care. What a beautiful image!



St. Francis of Assisi parish has supported the Un-Trim-A-Tree Program for more than 17 years, providing assistance for families in need in Dumfries, Triangle, and Quantico. This year St. Francis of Assisi will also be providing monetary donations to the following agencies: Birthright, Project Rachel and Gabriel, and Migration and Refugee of Catholic Charities. To assist you in the process we have some answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:

What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the requested date. **Do Not Wrap the present**

What is the tag for? **The tag is very important** as it indicates the individual's information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sorted and distributed. **When you pull a tag from one of the trees, copy the information down or take a picture of the tag** to ensure that if you lose the tag you will still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

Where do I drop the Present? Gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily.

Presents must be returned by Monday, December 14th.

(NO Exceptions)

Can I give additional items than those requests on the tag?
Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.
