A fresh perspective on the Sunday Readings

HIS WORD TODAY

“Then they came to Capernaum, and on the Sabbath Jesus entered the synagogue and taught. The people were astonished at his teaching, for he taught as one having authority and not as the scribes... All were amazed and asked one another: ‘What is this? A new teaching with authority. He commands even the unclean spirits and they obey him.’ His fame spread everywhere throughout the whole region of Galilee.”

Mark’s gospel finds Jesus in Capernaum, a town on the northern edge of the sea of Galilee. Today the focus is on the teaching role of Jesus. Last week we had the summary message, ‘The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel.’ His message is heard, and the people respond.

The same authority is found in the church’s teaching today. We are not to be cafeteria Christians, choosing to follow this point, but rejecting what doesn’t seem to please US, or challenges my way of life. May we embrace the teaching role of the church to direct our Christian lives in matters of faith morals.

The weekend of February 6th-7th the memorial of St. Blaise, *blessing of throats will be conferred after all the Masses.* The custom began in the 16th century, although Blaise lived in the fourth century. He was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia who, according to legend, saved the life of a boy who was choking on a fish bone. He is now the patron saint of all who have diseases of the throat. Please join us and receive a blessing of your throat as a sign of God’s care for his people.



Please note that due to the pandemic, the presider for each Mass will give the blessing to all assembled (NOT individually) by extending hands, without the crossed candles, over the people while saying the prayer of blessing.

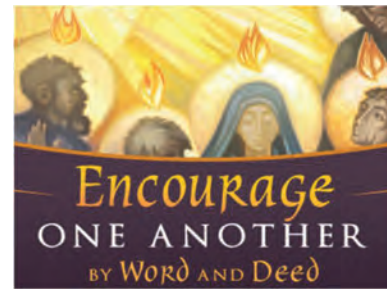

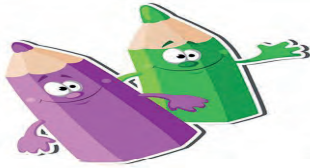
