Un-Trim A Tree Program

St. Francis of Assisi parish has supported the Un-Trim-A-Tree Program for more than 15 years, providing assistance for families in need in Dumfries, Triangle, and Quantico. This year St. Francis of Assisi will also be providing gifts for a number of refugee families' sponsored by Catholic Charities. To assist you in the process we have some answers to your frequently asked questions (FAQ'S) below:



What do I do with the tag? Take it home, shop for the gift and return the tag taped to the present by the request date.

What is the tag for? The tag is very important as it indicates the individual information, what the individual wants and also the way the gifts are sort and distributed.

Do I wrap the gift? NO. All gifts must be new and unwrapped, since this is the way we ensure the individual receives at least one of their wishes.

What if I lose the tag? When you get the tag home, copy the information down to ensure that if you lose the tag you still have the pertinent information like: name, sex, age, code, and wish.

What if I can't find the gift request on the tag? If you are unable to locate the requested gift, you can always buy a Gift Card so the parent or the individual can purchase the gift.

What if the gift request is too expensive? The guidelines for the Un-Trim-A-Tree program are that each individual gets two wishes with a maximum cost of \$35.00 per wish (this doesn't apply for the presents for the Refugee Families). If the present exceeds the maximum, you can always buy a Gift Card instead.

Does my present have to be back on the date requested? Yes! In order for us to meet the deadline, the present must be back on time. Keep in mind this is a huge program with over 700 children being served. If unable to fulfill a request, please return the tag back to the tree before December 7th.

What do I do with the Gift Cards? If purchasing a gift card, place the gift card with the tag in an envelope and drop it off at the Catch-All-box. Please do not put Gift Cards inside the presents.

Where do I drop the Present? On November 27th, St. Francis of Assisi placed a Christmas Angel Giving Tree on display in the vestibule of the church; gifts may be placed under the tree. They are removed daily. **Presents must be returned by Wednesday, December 16th.**

Can I give additional items than those requests on the tag? Yes, we always welcome and make good use of additional presents.
