**FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT**

 **From the Friars**

Please see below the Bishop's statement on the failure of congress to pass the Born Alive Abortion Survivors Act.

Needless to say I am shocked to see legislation that protects the life of a newborn voted down in the Senate. I echo the Bishop's words in encouraging you to write to our Virginia Congressional Senators expressing your disagreement over their actions.

*This joint statement has been issued by Most Reverend Michael F. Burbidge, Bishop of Arlington, and Most Reverend Barry C. Knestout, Bishop of Richmond:*

We are deeply dismayed and astounded that the U.S. Senate has failed to pass the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act (S. 311). It is a matter of common sense and basic human decency to require, as S. 311 would have, that any health care practitioner present when a child is born alive following an abortion give the same degree of care to preserve the life and health of the child as would be given to any other newborn. That this bill did not pass unanimously – let alone pass at all – is appalling and beyond comprehension. We are dismayed and outraged that Virginia's U.S. Senators Warner and Kaine voted against this critical lifesaving legislation.

We urge the Senate to reconsider its decision as soon as possible.

On a very different topic, please disregard any emails from myself that ask for money, help, iTunes cards etc. They are not from me! The only individuals that I would initiate an email with are members of the staff, friars, relatives and friends (not living in this area).

Someone is hacking parish data bases in the Arlington Diocese and sending bogus emails from pastors. This behavior has been reported to the Police in Prince William County and neighboring jurisdictions.

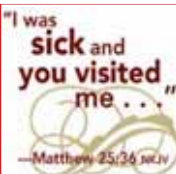
