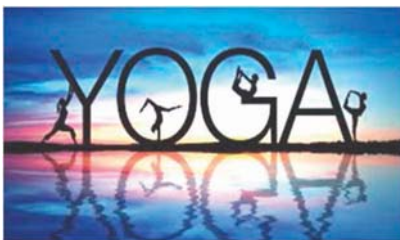

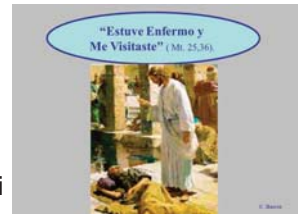

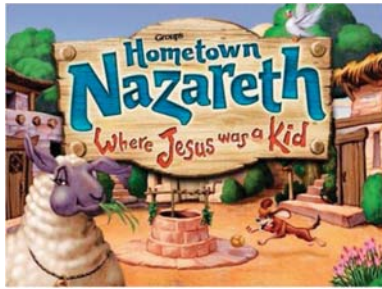

ECO-TIP:

Plastic bags do not biodegrade, they photodegrade—breaking down into smaller and smaller toxic bits. A plastic bag can take between 400 to 1,000 years to break down in the environment. As it breaks down, plastic particles contaminate soil and waterways and enter the food web when animals accidentally ingest them. Plastic bags cause over 100,000 sea turtle and other marine animal deaths every year. The average family accumulates 60 plastic bags in only four trips to the grocery store. Reducing your use of plastic bags is a simple action with huge impact. Buy reusable grocery bags and take them with you to the grocery store.

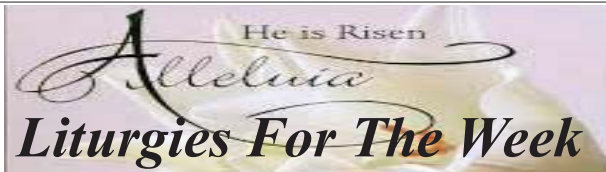

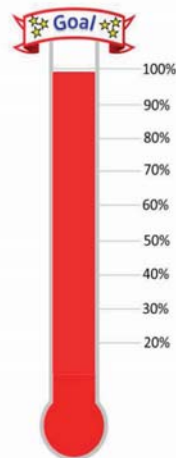
2019 Bishop's Lenten Appeal Together in the Light of Christ

Currently our parish has reached **98%** of our goal for the Bishop's Lenten Appeal (BLA). We are very grateful to those who have already supported this year's appeal.

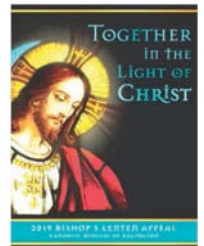
We know that there are families who have not yet made a pledge to the BLA and we are asking for support from every parish household.

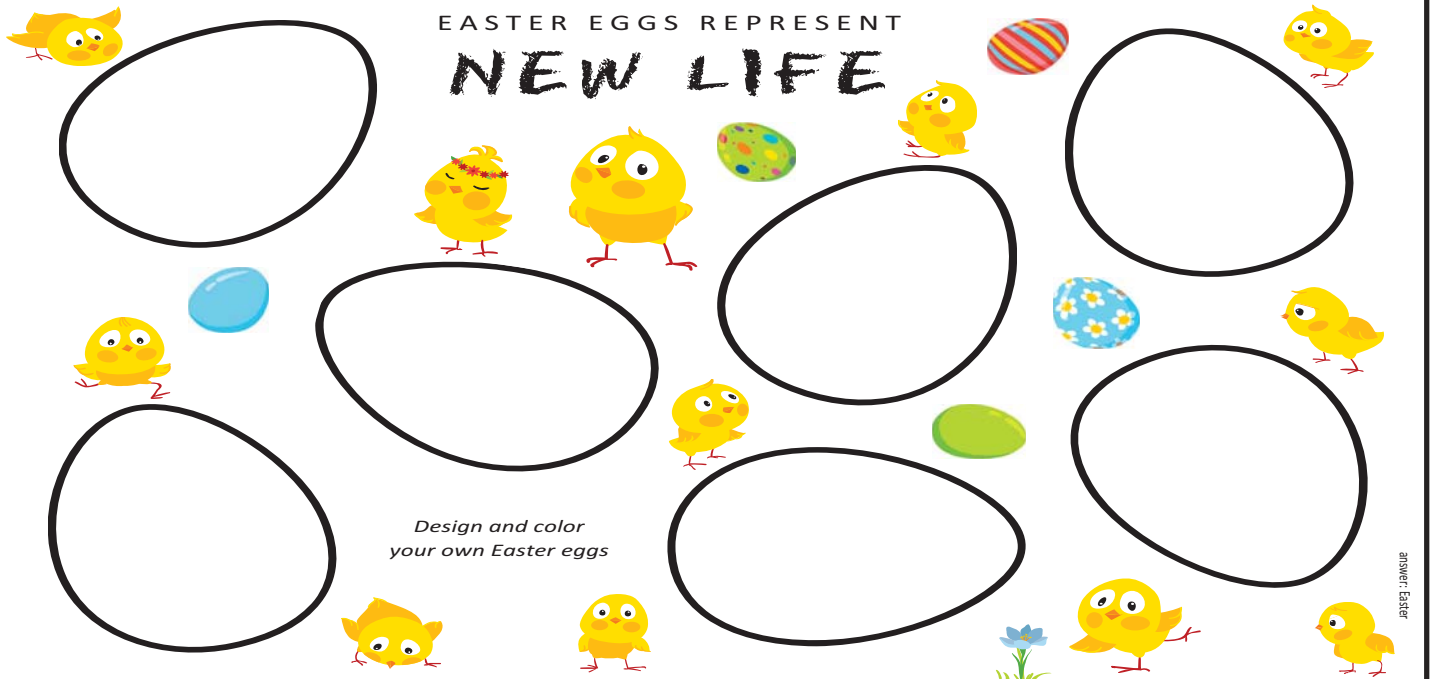

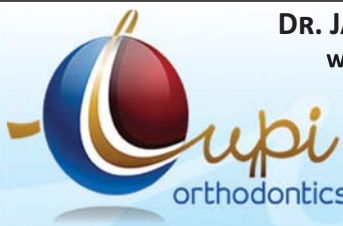
