Who lives in Holy Name Province?

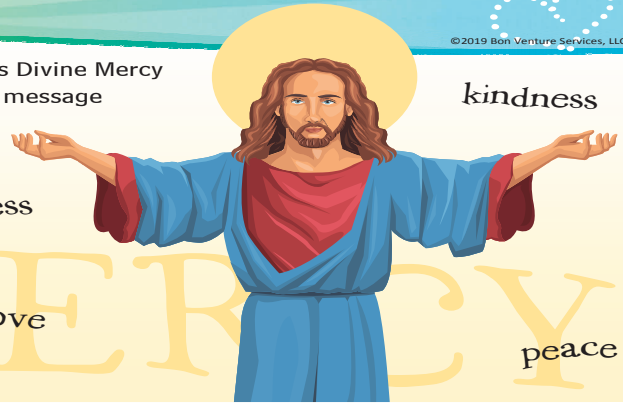
