### Catholic Diocese of Arlington and Immigration

The Catholic Diocese of Arlington is proactive in its outreach to the immigrant community. Our Spanish Apostolate and the Office of Multicultural Ministries work with immigrants and migrants through pastoral ministry and serve as a resource for current advocacy from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. Many of the immigrants in our area qualify for legal status but need help in obtaining it. Catholic Charities has staff whose principal duties include providing newcomer services and overseeing the immigrant and refugee programs in the Diocese.

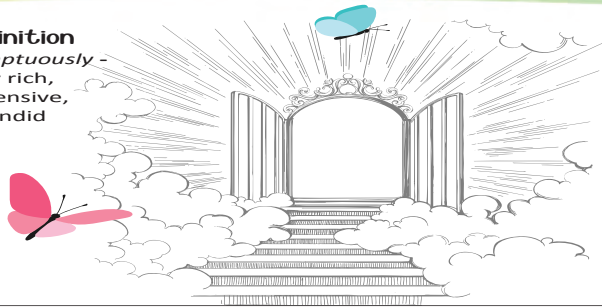
